*****Gov/Economics:** required for high school graduation and satisfies the UC g elective requirement.

*****Language/Vis Arts** (the high school graduation requirement) may NOT be Language for UC f requirement for Visual and Performing Art

******Electives:** 60 credits required for high school graduation

Required Area	High School Graduation	College Eligibility
1. Coursework	210 credits total minimum	15 year long courses total minimum. Selective colleges often look for more rigorous courses and courses beyond the minimum requirement/recommendation.
2. Minimum grade	D or higher	C or higher. Selective colleges are looking for the best grades
3. GPA	No requirement	UC 3.0 or higher, CSU 2.0 or higher
5. College Entrance Tests	None	PSAT in October of junior year (optional). SAT or ACT w/ writing
